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re-sourcing the ready-made

Bangalore OutResourcing Workshop, Dec 4 2012 a transmediale event, hosted by Goethe Institute and in cooperation with the Sristhi School of Art, Design and Technology in Bangalore/CEMA - Center for Experimental Media Arts.

Summary:

Current terminology is: outsourcing, insourcing, multisourcing, co-sourcing, crowdsourcing.... but where is the "source"?

Taking the Duchampian readymade from the context of art history – and matching it with the globalization of economy. Trying to re-source the ready-made – in the sense that the "source" of the readymade is not only in art, but also in the economy of industrialization since the early 20^{th} century. Relating this to Mahatma Gandhi movement of the "spinning wheel", which became a major anti-colonial symbol, prefiguring contemporary d.i.y. (do it yourself) practice and theory.
