

Petition to resume the production of black ink by Horstmann and Steinberg for the field of lithography 6.4.2024

Printmaking knowledge is under threat! This is particularly evident in the increasing cessation of production of the materials required for printmaking. Since the artistic field of creation is currently the most important framework in which many craft techniques are used, handed down and further developed, our concern includes the resumption of the production of nib ink for lithography according to the recipe of the old batch number 28N 003009. It enables the printing, preparation, etching, firing and setting aside of the stones in equal measure. At the same time, only this nib ink guarantees a wide range of black tone values for a wide variety of printing applications.

This nib ink offers easy handling and dissemination of the lithographic technique from students to professional workshops.

The artistic and technical heritage of printmaking lithography, which the German UNESCO Commission gave additional weight to in 2018 by recognizing it as intangible cultural heritage, needs your support!
